

Pet ID Information for Oahu Residents

from the Hawaiian Humane Society

If your pet already has a microchip, **update** your contact information using the form below and mail to: Hawaiian Humane Society, 2700 Waialae Avenue, Honolulu, HI 96826; or fax it to 955-6034.

If you plan to **move off island**, you may also want to register your microchip number with AVID's national database. Call 800-336-2843, ext.5.

Honolulu's anti-litter law includes you and your pet.

Carry a plastic bag when you are out with your dog and dispose of his waste.

Dogs are required to wear a

County-issued license tag on a collar at all times. If your animal is lost, an ID can be your pet's ticket home. If the tag is lost, a replacement is available at no charge. Dog license applications are available at all satellite city halls, the Hawaiian Humane Society, the Licensing Division of the Honolulu Department of Finance, and online at www.hawaiianhumane.org.

When in public, **dogs should be on leash** at all times.

Identification is required for all cats; sterilization is required for all cats over 6 months old that are allowed outdoors. The Humane Society recommends

that cats be kept indoors to protect them from disease, accidents and wandering.

The Society is Oahu's official pet lost and found center, reuniting over 4,000 pets a year with their families.

Lost and found. Call the Humane Society immediately to report a lost or found pet: 946-2187.

Found animals should be brought to the Society's 24-hour animal incoming center at 2700 Waialae Avenue. If you've **lost** a pet, visit the Society to check for your lost pet and bring a photograph.

UPDATE YOUR MICROCHIP RECORD!

A few simple steps could mean a lost pet has a far better chance of returning home.

Recently moved to Oahu? Ensure you include your microchip number below, since your pet will be a new entry to our microchip database.

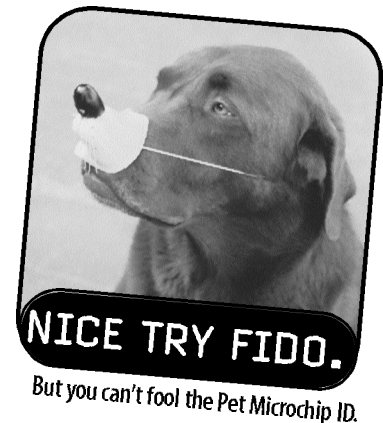
